This week in F2 we have been learning about Chinese New Year. We have learnt how people prepare for Chinese New Year by cleaning their homes and also learnt about the many traditions that happen across the 15 days of celebrations. The children particularly enjoyed learning about the dragon and lion dances and even got to see a real lion dance during assembly on Wednesday.

In Maths, we have been learning about the number 12. We have found one more and one less than twelve and also looked at which numbers are fewer or greater than 12. We have used ten frames and bobble heads to investigate different ways of making 12 and have also been counting to 12 using 1 pence coins

In Literacy we have been reading facts about Chinese New Year and we have also read a fiction text called *Dragons in the City* which told the story of two little girls as they celebrated Chinese New Year.

In Letters and Sounds we have learnt the diagraph *ee.* We have practised reading and writing words containing this grapheme. We have also been writing sentences with words containing the *ee* digraph. For example- He has got big feet.
