This week we have been reading the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We have heard the story and then used the language of *Once upon a time* and happily ever after when telling our own versions. In the Role-Play Area we have been acting out the story using props.

In Literacy we have been writing sentences using the tricky words – they, are and was and using the digraphs or, ar and ur. We have also been writing our own sentences about the wolf. For example: The wolf has got sharp teeth.

In Maths we have been focusing on the number 16. We have been adding and subtracting using 16. We have been practising counting on from the larger number when working out a total. (e.g. 10 and 6... put 10 in your head and count on.)

We celebrated the festival of Holi this week and used paint and brushes to create our own picture of colour. We had lots of fun splattering the paint all over the large paper.
