This week, we have been recapping some of our Maths and English skills. In Maths we've revisited looking at a range of skills including telling the time on an analogue clock and the properties of shapes. In English, we've been consolidating the idea of what a sentence is, and looking at either using a full stop or a conjunction (because, so, but etc.) to link ideas. In addition, we've practised spellings of high frequency words such as with, when, went. Similarly spelling of contracted word forms (can't, didn't, I'm) has been a focus.

We're really enjoying our History topic Grace Darling. This week we took part in a role play of the daily life of a Darling family member. During this activity we thought about how different life would have been for a child growing up in Victorian times.
