Year 2 Statutory Assessment Tests

Our Year 2 children have completed all of the Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs). We were so proud of how hard they worked and the resilience they demonstrated when faced with some quite challenging tasks. It was also rather hard for our staff because they were unable to offer any help which of course is quite unnatural.

The teachers will now use the assessments and evidence collated over the year to award the children a standard. Our school has been selected by the Local Authority to receive a moderation visit so our teacher assessments can be quality assured against local and national judgements. We are fortunate that Miss Murphy is also a Local Authority moderator so we are confident that the visit will go well. You will receive your child's assessment levels in their annual school report.

Sun Protection/Procedures

Uniform

Children should wear school uniform at all times except when it is their PE day. For safety reasons children need to wear appropriate footwear to school. Crocs, flip-flops or strappy sandals are not permitted. Socks should also be worn.

Sun Hats

On sunny days all children are expected to wear a sun hat. If your child does not already have a sun hat in school please could a labelled hat be sent in, which can be left in school for the remainder of the Summer Term. If you wish to purchase a Black Horse Hill sun hat these are available to buy on ParentPay at a cost of £4.50.

Sun Cream

Parents are requested to apply appropriate sunscreen for their children. This should be applied before the children come to school in the morning. If you have any concerns about this please speak to your child's class teacher. We do encourage children to find a shady space on hot days and we do limit time outside if it is extremely hot.

Water Bottles

Children should always have a waterbottle in school. These can be refilled throughtout the day from the water cooler outside my room. As we are a health-promoting school children should only have water in their bottles! We currently have a stock of Black Horse Hill water bottles in school which cost £1.50, please make payment on ParentPay.

Attendance

A reminder that (school) holiday requests cannot be approved in term time. Holiday leave may be granted in exceptional circumstances. The principles for defining exceptional are: 'rare, significant, unavoidable and short', with 'unavoidable' meaning an event that could not reasonably be scheduled at another time and proof of these elements would need to be obtained. The circumstance of 'Covid' would not meet this criteria.

It was helpful to hear the ideas about what we are doing well and how we can further improve provision for our children.
