This week in F2 we have been learning about the Arctic. We have learnt about the animals that live in the Arctic and have been exploring some new vocabulary — camouflage, predator, enemy, Earth and World.

In Maths, we have been naming 2D shapes — square, hexagon, triangle, circle and rectangle. We have used the mathematical language — corners, sides, straight, curved and 2D to talk about and describe these shapes. We have made repeating patterns using 2D shapes, e.g. circle, triangle, square, circle, triangle, square etc.

In Literacy we have been writing sentences independently. We have been using finger spaces, checking the sentence makes sense and making sure there is a capital letter.

In Letters and Sounds we have learnt the diagraph *ai*. We have practised reading and writing words containing this grapheme.

Please can you try to read your online book at home. This is the book your child has read with a teacher in school and is closely matched to their reading ability and the graphemes taught in Letters and Sounds.

Every Wednesday the children have the opportunity to visit the school library and choose a book to take home to share. Please ensure these books are returned to school each Wednesday so that a new book can be selected.

Please can you make sure your child has waterproof clothing, wellies and a PE kit in school. Please ensure these items are all clearly named.
