Your child will need to:

- a. Wear school uniform
- b. Bring a coat (they do not need their purple bag on this day)
- c. A pack lunch in a named brown paper bag or a backpack with a throw away drinks carton (if you are providing your own lunch)

We are sure that this will be a valuable learning experience for the children, but obviously their safety is paramount. We will require adult support. If you are interested in helping please complete and return the attached slip and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

As all children are now entitled to receive a school meal, a packed lunch will be provided by school. If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch, please complete the appropriate part of the form overleaf so we can notify the cook of numbers.
